Indonesia-Australia Pastoral Program

- Run by NTCA since 2012
- 20 Indonesian undergraduate animal science students per batch
- 6-week placements in Northern Australian cattle stations
- Helps build capacity, knowledge and understanding of the entire supply chain.
- Works to reinforce and strengthen cross-cultural relationships
- Reciprocal visit to Indonesia by the host stations
- Develop internships in Indonesian industry
- Ongoing commitment (2018 – 2020)

Skills development and training

- Policy Course (2015-2016)
- Processor Course (2015-2016)
- Producer Course (2015-2017)
- Supports skills and capability transfer for Indonesian government and industry representatives.
- Reaches key areas of the supply chain
- Aims to increase the understanding, knowledge and vocational skills of Indonesian future leaders and to promote global competencies.



Commercial Breeding Training

- Managed by AAI
- 20 staff of feedlots/oil palm plantations committed to breeding
- 2-weeks in Indonesia – Unpad
- 1-week in Australia – NTCA, NT DPIR
- Expose participants to different breeding models
- Involve site visits to IACCB partners and other farms in West Java, South Kalimantan and Lampung
- Ongoing commitment (2018 – 2020)
